






Our Aims



- To remain as a non-political educational institution promoting human dignity, justice, and global peace.
- To promote al-l'jāz al-Qur'ān al-Lughawī, the linguistic l'jāz of the Qur'an and 'Ulum al-Qur'an, the disciplines of the Qur'an. Award Research Fellowships to scholars and provide them required facilities. To plan and develop post-doctoral research on specific projects on the Qur'an and its disciplines with the assistance of internationally renowned scholars. To obtain published literature and manuscripts on these themes.
- To establish an archive on al-l'jāz al-Qur'ān al-Lughawī, the linguistic inimitability of the Qur'an and create online resources for the assimilation and dissemination of the literature the world over, free of cost to the student.
- To teach courses on Qur'anic Arabic, 'Ilm al-Tajwīd, the Science of the Recitation of the Qur'an, Arabic Script, Arabic Calligraphy and other disciplines.
- To establish a multi-purpose auditorium and organise symposia, seminars, workshops, conferences and public lectures.
- To undertake training programmes to develop professional skills for students and teachers.
- To mount a permanent exhibition on the Message of the Qur'an for the general public.
- To establish an educational Waqf, Pious Endowment for the educational needs of the Community.







Project Outline

What are the challenges being faced?

Globally in spite of the reverence and effort as individuals and communities, basic issues still exist:

- ◆ Inability of individuals to comprehend the Qur'an from its Arabic text.
- In some sections, misunderstanding of the Islamic position on key issues, e.g. violence, killing innocents and other 21st century challenges.

The result: Muslims remain defensive and not engaged fully within their societies and are unable to address the shared challenges.

Why do these complications exist?

In some sections deficiency in the comprehension of the Qur'anic world-view which is based on human dignity, justice and peace.

What is the solution being proposed?

A global central source – outlined in this project.


Why in Europe?

European libraries hold reputable collections of thousands of Arabic manuscripts, fulfilling the modern requirements for their safety. A large number of such manuscripts cover the area of QAF's study and research. Acquisition of such manuscripts and their careful examination will enable researchers to prepare critical editions, translation of their contents and their publication.









Our achievements (since 1993)

- ◆ Approximately 7000 men and women received free education in the foundation nine months free course.
- ◆ QAF in collaboration with IRF has produced a unique Qur'anic Arabic course composed of 77 half-hour episodes with colour visual aids. These episodes have been broadcasted via satellite television globally, enabling hundreds of students to learn Our'anic Arabic.
- ◆ Over three hundred teachers have been trained free of charge in Qur'ānic Arabic through intensive teacher training programmes based on modern teaching methods. The inaugural sessions of such courses took place at Aligarh Muslim University in India and the International Islamic University, Islamabad, which were chaired by their respective Vice-Chancellors.
- ◆ QAF has published on the themes of Arabic, the Qur'an and the Islamic Judicial System, and has distributed internationally thousands of volumes on a non-profit basis.
- QAF has published four closely linked courses on Qur'ānic Arabic leading from the script to higher level research.
- ◆ Thousands of copies of the booklet 'Islam the Qur'anic Overview' (32 pages) have been distributed in the world free of charge.
- ◆ Along with Qur'ānic Arabic QAF has taught a Qur'ānic script course for beginners and 'Ilm al-Tajwid courses for adults.
- ◆ QAF has recorded from its studio an 'Ilm al-Tajwīd course composed of 18 half-hour episodes as a free learning resource to accompany its textbook.



Research & Publication Unit

Our aim is to develop and house thousands of books and manuscripts, 8000 published works on the Qur'ān and its disciplines, Hadīth, Arabic Language and unique collections on al-l'jāz al-Qur'ān and the Islamic Judicial System. Scores of unpublished Arabic manuscripts are collected from different countries of the world.

- ◆ To establish a studio for recording QAF's academic pursuits.




The Existing Studio at QAF House shall be transferred to the new facility. Its facilities shall be extended. It will be possible to record effectively the intellectual pursuits of QAF:
